Committee Bylaws

(1) This committee is authorized and established by the Chancellor to serve as a policy advisory committee to the Provost, other campus-wide administrative officers and groups, and appropriate faculty groups. It reviews policies and administrative practices, either on its own initiative or upon referral, and thereafter makes recommendations to appropriate individuals or groups. It has the authority to limit the extent of its consideration of matters referred to it.

(2) The committee consists of the chair of the academic departments of Missouri S&T. It has the delegated authority to establish its own internal organizational structure.

FS 6/16/11 Minutes:

“The Department Chairs’ Council (DCC) consists of titled department chairs, including acting and interim Chairs and other officials who both supervise faculty and report to the Provost. The charge of the DCC is to be a collective voice for matters relevant to the departments. The DCC, acting in accordance with the General Faculty Bylaws and the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Curators, is charged with helping formulate, and issues which are of mutual concern to department chairs and their faculty. No statement or input from the DCC shall be construed to be representative of the faculty or its Standing Committees unless it first receives the endorsement of the Faculty Senate. The DCC shall consider all matters referred to it by the Board of Curators, the President of the University, the Chancellor, the Provost, the General Faculty, Faculty Senate, and individual department chairs.”
